REACHING STRIDES EQUESTRIAN CENTRE COVID-19 BARN RULES FOR PUBLIC TRAIL RIDES

- 1. PLEASE ensure that you-re social distancing at 6' at all times while you are at RSEC.
- 2. Upon arriving at the stables please walk to the picnic table by the riding ring. There you will be asked to use the hand sanitizer and to fill out your waivers if you didn't bring them with you.
- Waivers can be found on the lesson page of our website at the top of the page. www.reachingstrides.com
- 4. At this time our preferred payment is via e-transfer, which is due upon booking your ride. We do accept cash as well, but a 50% non-refundable deposit must be sent prior to arriving. (SORRY, NO CREDIT CARDS OR DEBIT)
- 5. We will provide trail riders with helmets, if you don't have your own. They will be brought up to the ring for you. Rest at ease that they are sprayed with dis-infectant after every use.
- 6. Please avoid touching anything unnecessary.
- 7. Trail riders will be asked to remain at ring side or in the car once paper work and funds are taken care of.
- 8. Once everyone is ready, we will bring your horse to the riding ring for you. Staff will direct you from there. Please hand sanitize before touching any tack on your horse.
- 9. For beginner trail riders, upon mounting you will be given a quick tutorial before you head out to the trails. Our staff will make every effort to keep a social distance of at least 6' at all times. If you need assistance that requires our staff to get closer then that, they will be equipped with gloves and a mask while helping you.
- 10. For our advanced hacks, riders will be given the history and quirks of their mount before heading out on the trails. (please bring your own helmet if you have one)
- 11. Upon returning from your ride, you will be asked to pass your horse to staff who will take care of your mount and put them away. Unfortunately, at this time until more restrictions are lifted, no one can be down at the stables except staff.
- 12. Please put your helmet on the picnic table for staff to dis-infect and put away.
